Definitions:

Initial Teacher Preparation Programs: *Programs at baccalaureate or post baccalaureate levels that prepare candidates for the first license to teach (NCATE 2000 Standards).*

Advanced Programs: *Programs at the post baccalaureate levels for (1) the continuing education of teachers who have previously completed initial preparation or (2) the preparation of other professional school personnel. Advanced preparation programs commonly award graduate credit and include master's, specialist, and doctoral degree programs as well as non-degree licensure programs offered at the graduate level (NCATE 2000 Standards).*
