***Friday, April 21 at noon*** in ***116 Aderhold***.

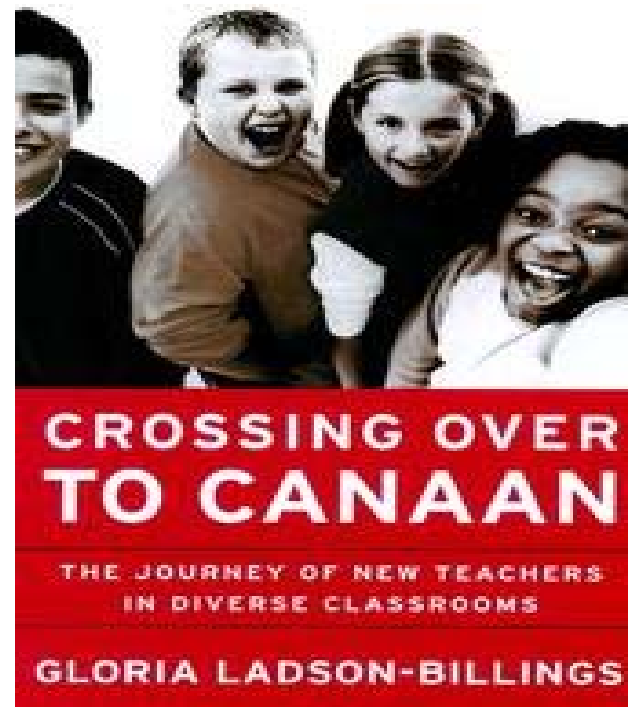
