The Speech and Hearing Clinic is located on the fifth floor of Aderhold Hall (College of Education) at the corner of East Campus Road and Green Street on The University of Georgia’s South Campus. Exit the bypass (Loop 10) on College Station Road, south to East Campus Road. Turn right onto East Campus. At the second traffic light, turn left onto Green Street. Aderhold Hall is the first building on the left. Turn into the second parking lot entrance. Client parking is the area in front of the building which is not gated.
