## Advising Checklist

### Education Specialist in Educational Psychology (Ed.S.)

This degree requires a minimum of 31 semester hours of course work beyond the Master's degree and an Applied Project. Students can pursue programs of study according to their experience in gifted education. **Novice Plan (N).** For individuals who have had little or no training or experience in gifted education, follow the course outline below as is. **Advanced Plan (A).** For individuals who have advanced training or experience in gifted education. Coursework for the novice plan is required, but students may be exempt from a course if they have completed it. Advanced students will complete the remaining hours for their program of study by completing coursework within the GCE emphasis areas or other areas based on academic interests. The student will choose coursework with an advisor's assistance and approval of the student's committee.
