Important Reminders

Registration

- € Please complete the registration forms and submit all fees by November 16, 2007. Those attending the conference must submit \$750 per person. Those also going on a post conference trip must submit \$1200 per person (the conference fee + \$450 for the post conference trip). Please make checks payable to the Torrance Center and send to the address on the application form.
- € Agreement for Participation in the UGA CREATE Conference/Release, Waiver of Liability and Covenant Not to Sue liability forms must be signed by the appropriate party or parties in order to participate in the conference.
- € Forms can be mailed to Rebecca Nordin at 323 Aderhold Hall, Athens, GA 30602, faxed to the Torrance Center at (706) 542-4659, or emailed to CREATE08@uga.edu.
- € If participants are unable to make full payment by November 16, 2007, please contact the Torrance Center at 506-542-4110 and let Rebecca Nordin know when the balance of the fees will be paid. A \$150 late fee will be charged to participants for late submittals, unless otherwise arranged with the conference coordinators.
- € Notify the conference coordinators of the telephone number at which you can be contacted over the December holidays.
- € The final date to withdraw from the conference is November 16, 2007.

Health

- € Remember to discuss any concerns you have about managing chronic illnesses (diabetes, asthma, etc.) while traveling with your doctor.
- € Although no immunizations are required specifically for travel to Costa Rica, the UGA Travel Clinic recommends the Hepatitis A & B vaccine as well as tetanus boosters for all international travelers.
- € A complete health exam is recommended.

Non-U.S. Citizens

- € If you are not a U.S. citizen and will be traveling to Costa Rica under the passport of another country, there are steps you must take now to make sure you can enter Costa Rica and then re-enter the U.S.
- € If you are not a U.S. citizen, call the Office of International Affairs at 706-425-3154; we can guide you through the necessary steps. You may also wish to contact your home country's embassy or consulate.

Reminders

- € Make sure you have an updated passport.
- € Please check your email regularly. We will notify you of any changes or updates by email.
- € Notify the conference coordinators of the telephone number at which you can be contacted over the December holidays.
- € You will be able to use U.S. dollars and will not need to change your money in Costa Rica.
- € We are not allowed to sell wine or other libations at the lodge. If you want to partake, you should buy these things at the airport before you come to campus.
