Qualifications:

Application Procedures:

1. Application file must contain a completed, typed or neatly hand-written application form, a typed one-page (300 words maximum) personal statement, financial statement, and three letters of recommendation.
2. A copy of the Financial Aid Award Letter available through OASIS must be provided.
3. The completed application, three letters of recommendation, financial statement and the Oasis Financial Aid Award letter must be submitted to the following address by May 1st or November 1st of the Block 2 Semester.
