The College of Education's Curriculum Committee has had a successful and busy academic year. Dr. Patricia S. Wilson (Mathematics and Science Education), and Dr. Evan Powell (Educational Psychology and Instructional Technology) were elected to begin new terms of office. Dr. Sally Zepeda chaired 6 regularly scheduled meetings. The minutes and agenda items are available electronically at:

The curriculum committee passed 107 new courses of which 55 or 51.40% were at the graduate level. There were 43 course changes, and 12 proposals for new programs. Within the 107 new courses proposed, the majority were from the following departments: Kinesiology Department (39), Elementary and Social Studies Education (16), Language and Literacy Education (14), and Educational Psychology and Instructional Technology (13).

There are 22 courses yet to be decided on by the University Curriculum System, 17 at the University Curriculum sub-committee level, and 5 at the Executive Council level. The attached chart summarizes the curriculum committee's activity to date.

Of the 43 course changes, the majority were initiated by the Educational Psychology and Instructional Technology, and Elementary and Social Studies Education Departments each with 14. These changes, for example, were generally name changes, with ERSH changing prefixes to QUAL.
