## PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING TO THE MAJOR IN EXERCISE AND SPORT SCIENCE

### Department of Kinesiology

The Exercise and Sport Science major in the Department of Kinesiology is classified as a restricted major, which has a limited enrollment. Therefore, students need to follow the procedures below in order to be considered for admission into the major.

#### Selection Process:

In order to be considered for full acceptance into the Exercise and Sport Science Major, a student must have an overall GPA of 2.75 or better and a grade of C or better in Area F required courses. A student in the process of completing the required course work in Area F may be “provisionally accepted,” contingent upon satisfactorily completing the required courses while maintaining a GPA of 2.75 or greater.

Students will submit an application (see attached) along with a typed essay no longer than 750 words on their background related to exercise and sport science, career goals, and how their admission to the major will assist them in achieving their career goals. Each year, approximately 75 students are accepted. Quotas for number of students accepted fall, spring and summer semesters (totaling 75) are established at the beginning of the year. Each semester, applicants are rank ordered based on GPA for Area F courses, selected course work in Area A and D, and the essay. The highest ranking students up to the quota for that semester are admitted. Simply meeting the minimum criteria for applying will not guarantee acceptance.

All application materials should be forwarded to Dell Whitehead, undergraduate advisor in the Department of Kinesiology, Room 304 of the Ramsey Student Center before the application deadline. There will be three application periods each year. The Fall application deadline is the third Friday in September; the Spring application deadline is the third Friday in January; and the Summer application deadline is the third Friday in June. Notification of acceptance, provisional acceptance, or non-acceptance will be mailed to you approximately three weeks after the submission date.
