- ⇒  **Submission of Payments**
  - February 14, 2005 = \$300**
  - March 2, 2005 = \$1500**
  - April 4, 2005 = \$1600**
  - April 4, 2005 = \$ 800 Tanzania Mt. Kilimanjaro Climb**

- ⇒  **Health Record for Overseas Programs** - Submit to Dr. Jepkorir R. Chepyator-Thomson or Dr. Norman Thomson on Friday, **April 4, 2005**. Kenya requires no International Inoculation Certificate, Tanzania and Uganda require it for yellow fever and Uganda recommends cholera. The Certificate is issued after administration, valid for 10 years. See <http://www.cdc.gov/travel/>

- ⇒  **Purchased airline tickets** – we will let you know the agent, carrier, and flight details.

## Passport



- ⇒  **Current Passport** - You must have a valid passport to exit and re-enter the United States. (Locally, applications for passports may be made at the Athens Post Office on Olympic Drive). Passport services and information may also be obtained from the U.S. Department of State:

## Visas



- ⇒  **Visa for Kenya** Citizens of the United States require a visa for entry into Kenya for visits. The cost is \$50 for multiple-entry (3 months) given upon arrival at Kenyatta International Airport. Other Nationals should check with a Kenya Embassy <http://www.kenyaembassy.com/> or Consulate Office.

- ⇒  **Visa for Tanzania** . Citizens of the United States require a visa for entry into Tanzania for visits. Single entry 6 month is US\$ 50, multiple entry 3 month is \$ 60. Tanzania's Embassy in the U.S:

- ⇒  **Visa for Uganda** Citizens of the United States require a visa for entry into Uganda for visits. Single entry 3 month US\$ 50. An international inoculation certificate against yellow fever is required for entry. Uganda's Embassy in the U.S. is: <http://ugandaembassy.com/>
