Dear Parent or Guardian:

Thank you for your inquiry about the University of Georgia Reading Clinic. In addition to this letter (available for download on our website), there are two forms which must be filled out and returned to us so that your child may be placed on our waiting list. The next clinic will begin Spring 2012, and meet every Thursday evening 6:00pm-7:00pm beginning February 2nd through April 19th (except UGA's Spring Break March 15th). There is a one time clinic fee of \$100 due the first day of clinic. This fee can be reduced or even waived, and you can discuss this with us that first day.

Because the clinic runs in coordination with a graduate level class, **we will not be able to inform you of your child's acceptance until mid-January 2012, when registration for classes is complete and the class rolls are finalized.** We appreciate your concern with clinic enrollment and strive to serve as many children as possible. Therefore, **our office will make every attempt to contact you in a timely manner regarding clinic enrollment upon the completion of registration.**
