STUDENT TEACHING SCHOLARSHIP

The College of Education has a limited number of scholarships, which are awarded each fall and spring semester on the basis of financial need. This will depend on the number of qualified applicants who apply each semester, and the amount of money available from the Student Teaching Scholarship funds at that time.
