What study abroad opportunities are available for UGA Students?

The University of Georgia offers over 80 study abroad programs to its students. UGA is also member of various consortia and affiliated with organizations that offer additional programs. However, our students are not limited to these opportunities but can select from any of the thousands of programs offered by American universities or directly enroll in a foreign university for a semester, academic year or summer.

How do I obtain information on study abroad?

If you are interested in studying, working, volunteering or interning abroad, we encourage you to attend one of three **Options Abroad Sessions**. In these 50 minute sessions we explain the basics of finding a study abroad program, using the resources in our study abroad library, the process of transferring credit from a non-UGA study abroad program, financial aid and scholarships for study abroad, health and insurance, basic travel information, information on working, volunteering, or interning abroad, SISA and SA-Talk, as well as the study abroad listserv. Please call our office at 542-7903 to find out session information. You must sign up for a session, as there is limited space available.

How might this affect the courses I choose to take while at UGA?

Prior planning for study abroad will likely prevent any delay in completing your degree requirements. In most departments, there is a limit to the number of courses taken outside the university that can be applied toward your major or minor. Therefore, you may want to save core curriculum and elective courses for your time abroad. Talk to your advisor about these issues and determine the courses that would be most suitable for you to take abroad.
