

GOLF FOR BUSINESS & LIFE SYLLABUS

The Golf for Business & Life course number is “PEDB1121” and has one session with a maximum of 24 students per class. Each session will have 32 hours of instruction. Golf Professional Teacher Ratio will be on an 8 to 1 basis. Registration for the 1 credit hour class is online. Cost is \$350 per person.

Sessions will be offered Tuesdays & Thursdays from 3:35pm to 5:30pm. Spring 2007 class starts on February 1st and ends on April 26th.

This program is partially funded by a donation made by 2002 & 2004 Ryder Cup Team Member Davis Love III.

Goals for this class include:

- **To develop an appreciation and knowledge of the history and origin of golf.**
- **To perform golf skills (full swing, pitching, chipping and putting) with proficiency.**
- **To enjoy and appreciate golf’s contributions to personal exercise and pleasure.**

Objectives for this class include:

- **To gain knowledge and be able to apply golf terminology, rules and etiquette.**
- **To understand and apply biomechanical principles and individual preferences related to an individual’s golf abilities.**
- **To play a 9-hole round of golf.**
- **To understand and appreciate the challenges golf presents to the skilled performer.**
- **To use safety precautions on the practice area and golf course.**
