



eLearning Commons (eLC) FAQ

Do email forwarding settings apply for all courses in which a user is enrolled?

Yes. The email forwarding setting is globally applied to all courses. It is not possible to have a different setting for each course.

Establishing mail forwarding is a two step process; 1) from the eLC home page, click 'My Settings' link. Click the 'My Profile' tab. Click the 'Edit Profile' button. Modify the e-mail field as appropriate. Click the 'Save' button. 2) Click the 'My Tool Options' tab. In the Mail section of the page, check the 'Mail forwarding' box. Click the 'Save' button.

Does eLC allow ungraded assignments?

Yes. When creating an assignment, the Grading section allows the course designer to specify if the assignment is graded and the name of the column in the grade book into which grades will be stored.

Is it possible to edit an assignment after creation?

Some aspects of an assignment such as description, instructions, due date, cutoff date and grading can be changed; type of submission and the assignment recipients cannot be changed. Click the Assignment action menu, choose 'Edit Properties'. One should be careful if assignments have already been submitted by students as modifying an assignment's properties may affect previous submissions.

Do Assignments support e-portfolio type interactions.

It is possible for assignments to require the submission of 'zip'ped website (relative links). Upon review, the instructor may provide feedback and then a) send the assignment back to the student for changes b) grade the assignment. The assignment can be returned to student multiple times. Instructor comments are retained (there is only one submitted document). It does not appear that data about submissions is retained (i.e. how many submissions, improvement per submission, etc.).
