C. Courses of Instruction

Introduction to Computers for Teachers (EDIT 2000). The computer and its educational applications for preservice teachers. Computer-based education in the areas of instruction, text and data processing, multimedia, and telecommunications. Emphasis on integrating computer tools into class instruction.

Introduction to Instructional Technology (EDIT 6100). The field of Instructional Technology, situating the field within the context of its historical perspective, current practices, and future directions.

Introduction to Computer-Based Education (EDIT 6150). The computer and its educational applications. Computer-based education in the areas of instruction, text and data processing, multimedia, and telecommunications. Philosophical perspectives on the role of computer technology in education.

Administration of Media Programs (EDIT 6300). Management of resources, services, and functions of the school media program. Students develop a vision and plan for improving collections, technical services, and promotion activities.

Information Services in School Media Programs (EDIT 6340). Students analyze criteria for planning, selecting, using, and evaluating a variety of electronic and print resources for information services in schools.

Cataloging for Automated Media Centers (EDIT 6380). Prepares media specialists for cataloging materials in machine-readable (MARC) record format for automated catalogs. The student learns to use the Dewey Decimal Classification System for classifying all types of materials, the Sears subject headings for categorizing materials, and MARC software for creating records in machine-readable (MARC) format.

Research in School Media Services (EDIT 7320). Identifies contemporary problems in the field of school media services around which students design appropriate research studies.

Issues in School Media Programs (EDIT 7340). Explores contemporary trends, problem areas, and issues in management of school media programs through literature investigations, seminar discussions, and case studies.

Internship in Instructional Technology (EDIT 7460). On-site experiences under supervision of qualified persons in the field. Students maintain and submit a log, journal, or other documentation of their experience.

Doctoral Topical Seminar (EDIT 9990). Examination of topical issues in instructional technology.
