Endorsement Requirements for
Diversified Cooperative Training (DCT)

An individual with the Diversified Cooperative Training (DCT) endorsement is in-field to coordinate programs in grades 7-12. To add DCT an applicant shall:

- A. possess a professional certificate at the bachelors or higher certification level in any teaching field, the service field of School Counselor, or the leadership fields of administration and supervision or director of vocational education provided that a teaching field prerequisite has been established for the service or leadership field
- B. complete an approved program in DCT or complete 12 semester hours of acceptable college credit to include the following:

- 3 semester hours in foundations of vocational education programs

The current course to satisfy this requirement is: EOCS 6010 Foundations of Work and Family Life Education.

- 3 semester hours in the coordination and delivery of cooperative programs

The current course to satisfy this requirement is: EOCS 5030-7030 Organizing and Coordinating Work and Community-Based Education Programs.

- 3 semester hours in curriculum development and teaching methods in cooperative programs

The current course to satisfy this requirement is: EOCS 4100-6100 Principles and Practice of Career Education.

- 3 semester hours in a DCT internship

The current course to satisfy this requirement is EOCS 7460 Internship in Teaching Workforce Education (formerly Occupational Studies).
