Endorsement Requirements for
Director of Technology/Career Education (DTCE)
(Formerly Director of Vocational Education)

An individual with the Director of Technology/Career Education endorsement is in-field to direct, administer, or supervise Technology/Career Education programs in grades P-12. To be eligible for the Director of Technology/Career Education Endorsement an applicant shall:

- A. hold a masters or higher degree from a PSC-accepted, accredited institution
- B. hold a professional certificate in the fields of Agricultural Education, Business Education, Family and Consumer Sciences Education, Healthcare Science Technology Education, Marketing Education, Technology Education, Trade and Industrial Education, or any other specific Technology/Career Education field
- C. complete a state approved program in the Director of Technology/Career Education Endorsement or 9 semester hours of acceptable college credit to include the following:

- 3 semester hours in organizational leadership

The current course to satisfy this requirement is: **EOCS 8060** Administration and Supervision of Occupational Studies Programs

- 3 semester hours in supervision of instruction

The current course to satisfy this requirement is: **EDAP 7020** Supervision of Instruction

- 3 semester hours in curriculum development.

The current course to satisfy this requirement is: **EOCS 7080** Developing Curricular and Programs for Modern Work
