*Endorsement Requirements for*  
**Career Exploration (PECE)**

An individual with the Career Exploration (PECE) endorsement is in-field to teach career exploration and to coordinate programs in grades 7-12. To add PECE an applicant shall:

- A. possess a professional certificate at the bachelors or higher certification level in any teaching field or the service field of School Counselor provided that a teaching field prerequisite has been established
- B. complete an approved program or earn 20 quarter hours of acceptable college credit to include the following:

- 3 semester hours in the introduction to educational and career exploration

The current course to satisfy this requirement: **EOCS 4100-6100** Principles and Practices of Career Education

- 3 semester hours in occupational information service

The current course to satisfy this requirement is: **EOCS 6010** Foundations of Work and Family Life Education

- 3 semester hours in group dynamics in relation to work roles used in teaching career exploration

The current course to satisfy this requirement is: **EOCS 5030-7030** Organizing and Coordinating Work and Community-Based Education Programs.

- 3 semester hours in an internship including career exploration on a full-time basis for a period of nine months or longer

The current course to satisfy this requirement is: **EOCS 7460** Internship in Teaching Workforce Education (formerly Occupational Studies).
